

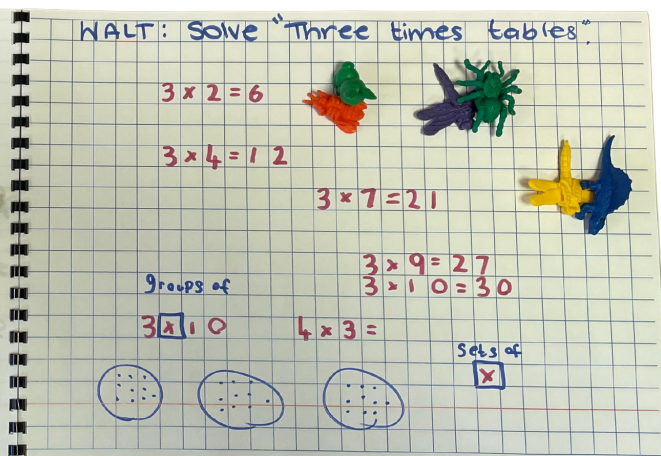

The Group 4 team have been taking a new approach to teaching and organising maths. They are also exploring the use of modelling books to scaffold student understanding.

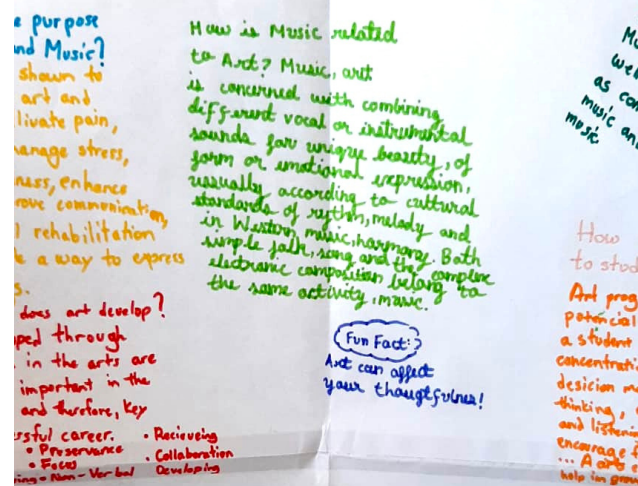

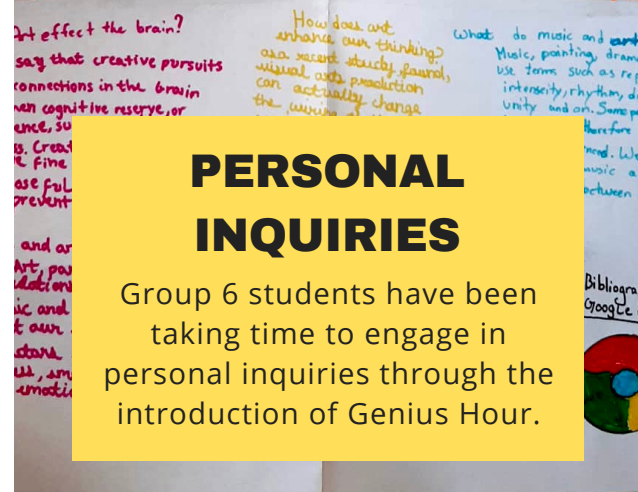
THROUGH THE LENS

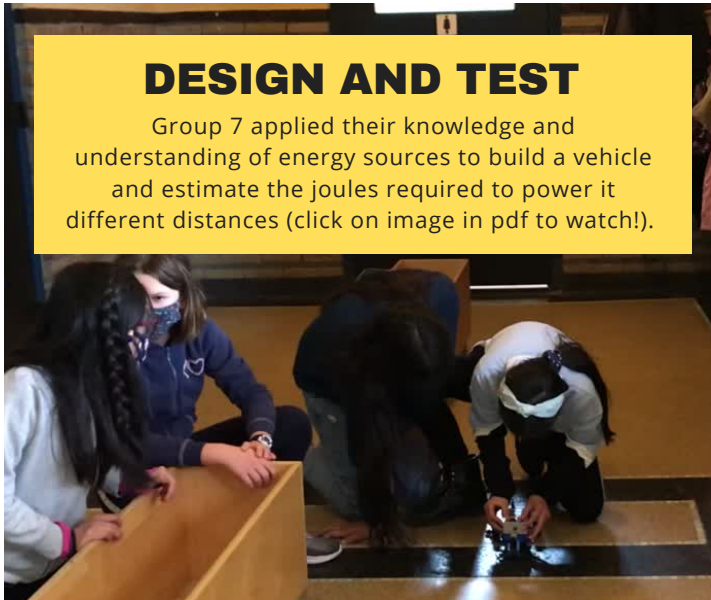
PERSONAL INQUIRIES

Group 6 students have been taking time to engage in personal inquiries through the introduction of Genius Hour.



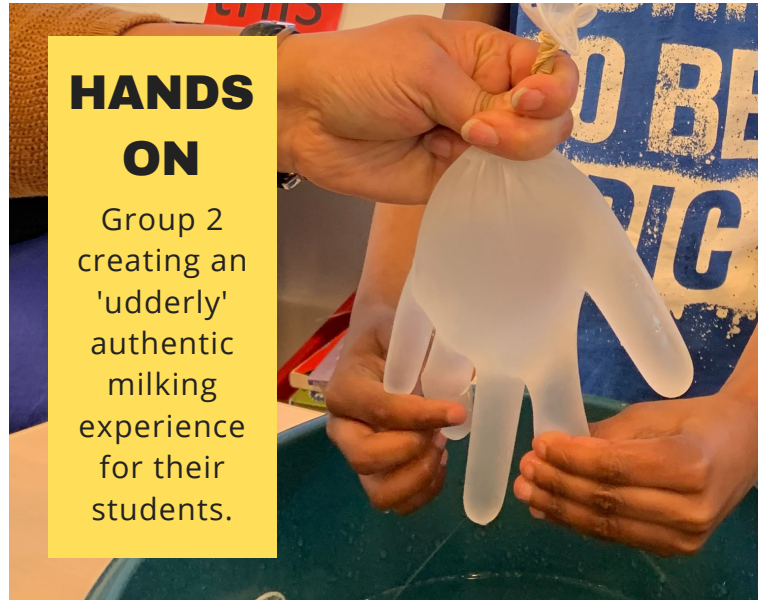
DESIGN AND TEST
