

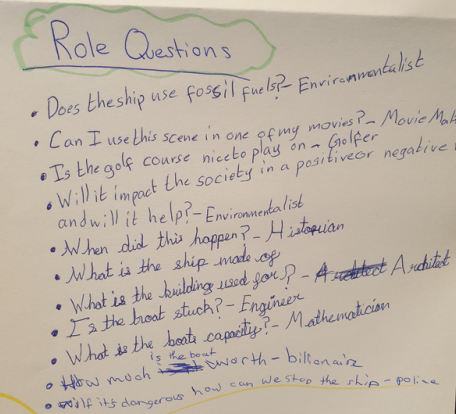

QUESTION FORMULATION TECHNIQUE (QFT)

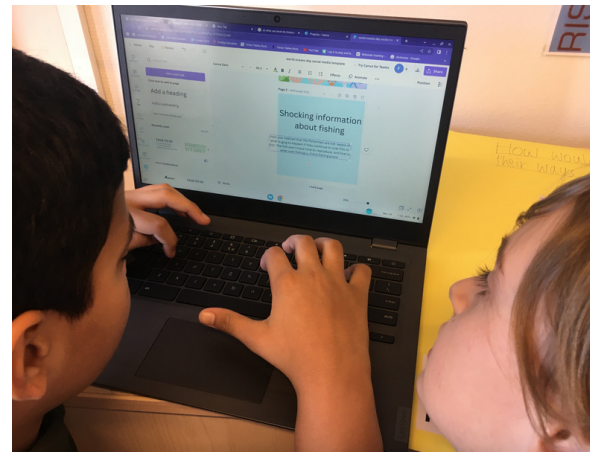
Group 7 students worked together to write their observations around an interesting image before they asked questions.



They asked role questions from the perspective of an artist or a politician, a doctor or an engineer... any role they could think of!

ROLE AUDIENCE PRODUCT (RAP)

Group 6 students presented their inquiry cycle projects using the RAP technique. They made video advertisements, news reports and undercover documentaries.



COLLABORATIVE ARTISTIC PROCESS

Group 5 students brainstormed storyboard ideas and chose a setting, characters and plot. Then they crafted a scene which they used for their stop motion film.
