In Group 7, students are using drama as a medium for sharing their understanding about the development of different pillars of society through time.

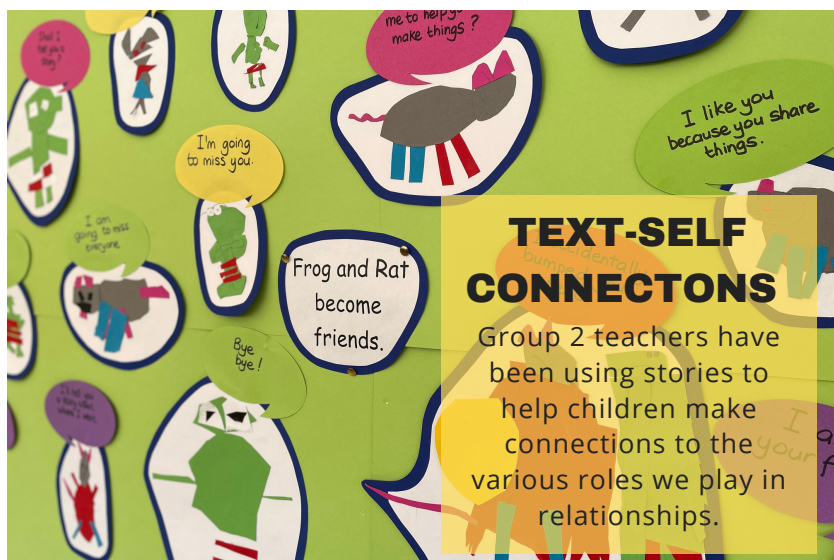

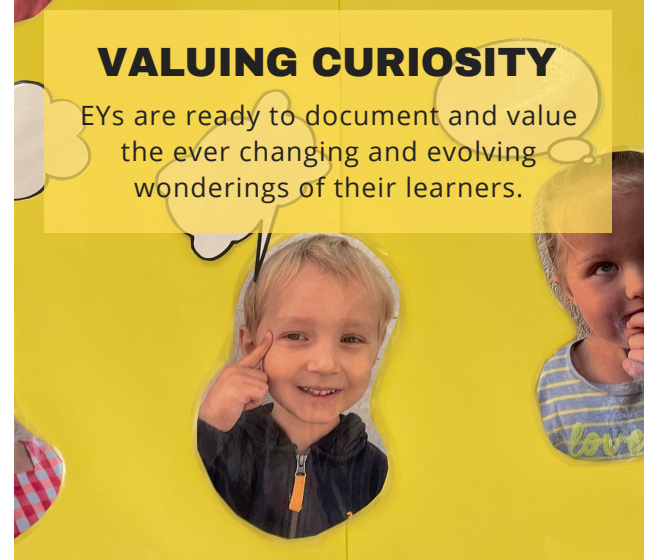


TEXT-SELF CONNECTIONS

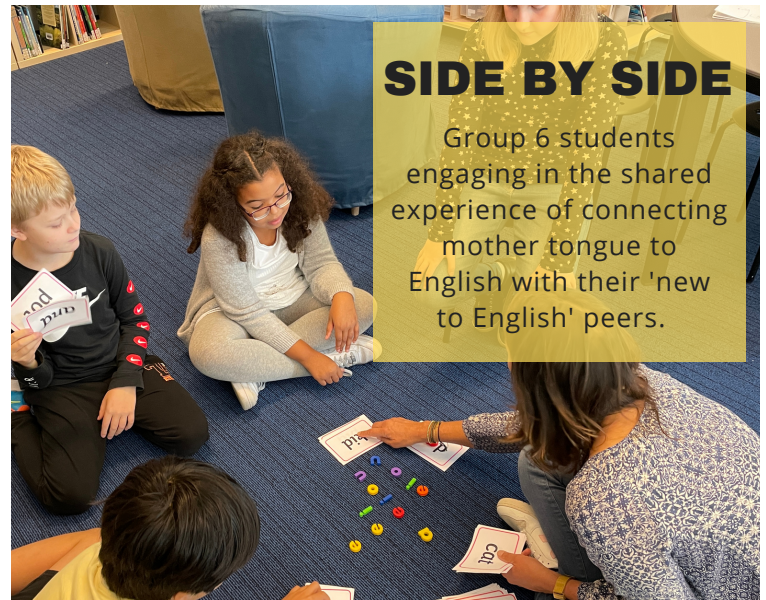
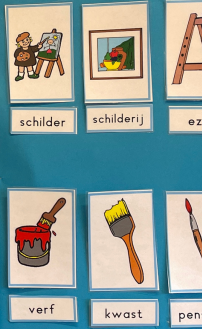
