Kiss & Ride

Kiss & Ride will resume on Monday, and from 08:25 you can drop off in the Kiss & Ride zone. The Kiss & Ride zone is a short-parking area, at the side of the school (on Vermeerlaan). In this area, parents who are driving may drop off children here; however, the no parking rules still apply.

No Parking Rules

1. Stop time necessary to drop off children safely
2. Driver must remain in the car
3. Vehicle must not be left unattended
4. No stopping (even for drop-off!) in front of the Rembrandt
5. No stopping anywhere in the junction
6. No double parking
