

Tommy Tomato

On Wednesday, you received an email on Toddle: Learning about vegetables & free tryout lunch sent from the Tommy Tomato school food service. Your child has the opportunity to participate in a free lunch if you sign up via the link provided in the email.





Sign your child up for the free tryout lunch at <u>Rembrandt</u> on Monday 13 May, and at <u>Mondrian</u> on Tuesday 14 May.

After the tryout lunch, if your child liked the meal, you can register them for Tommy Tomato's vegetable lunch once a week for a six-week trial period. This costs €3.25 per lunch at Rembrandt and €3.75 at Mondrian. **Too expensive?** Indicate this when registering and Tommy Tomato sponsors will help pay. This is done on a trust basis; you are not required to submit any evidence.


