Stip and Kei Klas



Since this school year, both the Stip Class and the Kei Class are located on the first floor of the Mondrian Campus of IPS Hilversum. This marks a wonderful connection with the other Stip schools in Hilversum. While there is not yet direct collaboration with our school, we hope that in the future there will be opportunities for inspiring crossovers in the future!

The Stip Class is designed for students with a “fast brain” (groups 5 to 8) who need more challenge than regular classroom teaching can offer. Once a week, during school hours, small groups of students attend the Stip Class, guided by a teacher specialized in gifted education. The program focuses on learning strategies, growth mindset, social development, and building a positive

self-image. Children also practice important skills such as learning to fail, cope with setbacks, and persevere—competencies that will support them throughout their education.

The Kei Class focuses on students with practical talents. Throughout the week, different groups of children come to work within six domains, where they explore hands-on skills and assignments. It is an environment that fosters curiosity, self-confidence, and the discovery of personal strengths, while preparing students for secondary school and beyond.

We are delighted that these special initiatives have found a home in our school building and look forward to the opportunities this may bring in the future.
