Road Closures August to October 2026

From August 24 to October 4, 2026, Stationsstraat will be closed to cars and cyclists due to work on cables, pipes, and the sewer system. Pedestrians will still be able to use the street. Due to the closure, a diversion route will be established. Traffic will be temporarily diverted via Koninginneweg, Schoolstraat, and Langgewenst. Additionally, the bus stop on Stationsstraat will be temporarily relocated to Langgewenst. Bus lines will stop there to transport passengers to their destinations. We kindly ask you to inform parents, students, and staff about this and, where possible, to take into account extra travel time and adjusted routes.
